Last night's banquet was a fun-filled evening for all. Many reconnections were made, memories shared, and stories told throughout the night. Approximately 150 guests were in attendance. The evening's highlight was the induction of four individuals into the Ancient Skiers Hall of Fame. These honorees were nominated by fellow Ancient Skiers for their exceptional energy, enthusiasm, and passion for skiing. They have made significant contributions to the sport over many years, helping to increase public awareness and appreciation of skiing and bringing lasting fame to snow sports in the Northwest. Every member of the Ancient Skiers club had the opportunity to vote among seven candidates. Here are our newest honorees:

Leland Rosenlund

Leland is a longtime member of the Ancient Skiers and has served on the board. He began skiing at Snoqualmie at an early age and worked in the ski industry, initially at Osborn and Ulland for 10 years and then with Sports Unlimited for 42 years. He also taught skiing and helped start the Powder Pigs Ski School.

Mike Ewing

Mike came to Crystal Mountain for the 1965-66 ski season, working with the National Ski Safety Research. He coached for the Crystal Mtn Mighty Mites program and worked in the Crystal Mtn Ski Shop. Mike has worked in the ski industry for A & T Ski Company, Lange Ski Boots, and K2 Ski Company. He has been a PSIA-certified instructor since 1965 and will soon receive his 60-year pin from PSIA.

Laurie Macartney

Laurie started skiing at Snoqualmie Pass in junior high and became a ski instructor there while in high school. She spent 46 years with the Crystal Mtn ski patrol, earning numerous awards from the National Ski Patrol. Laurie's last year of patrolling was in 2016, when she lost her battle with breast cancer.

Stanley Larsen

Stanley was one of the earliest influencers in the global development of freestyle skiing as an organized sport. He was a featured skier in ski films by Dick Barrymore and Warren Miller, won the Overall Combined European Freestyle Champion in 1974, and was a founding member of the Professional Freestyle Associates. Stan shared a collection of photographs and images from the first half of his career as a professional skier and filmmaker, spanning 1969 to 1989.

Seven Ancient Skiers participated in the Meet and Greet Golf Event before the banquet. It was a bit windy and wet, but great fun nonetheless. We've all had some ski days like that!

Ski Industry News

Let's Go to The Movies!

In Seattle, the 75th Warren Miller ski film, All Time, will be showing at McCaw Hall on November 23, 2024. This iconic annual release from Warren Miller Entertainment features a mix of breathtaking segments filmed in snowy landscapes worldwide, with top athletes like Shaun White and Lexi duPont. The screening at McCaw Hall is part of the national tour celebrating Warren Miller's legacy in ski cinema. All Time will also play in Olympia on November 7, Tacoma on November 16, and Enumclaw on November 22. If you're lucky enough to be in Sun Valley this fall, you can catch the movie at the Silver Mountain Theatre on November 29 and 30.

Additionally, Teton Gravity Research's latest film, Beyond the Fantasy, will be shown nearby at The Chalet Theatre in Enumclaw, WA, on November 8, 2024, for those interested in high-adrenaline ski action close to Seattle.

Sun Valley Resort is hosting a showing of *Calm Beneath Castles*, a Matchstick Productions film on November 22. This film is an aweinspiring ski movie that delves into the heart, soul, and mind of skiers driven by an insatiable thirst for adventure and discovery.

What's New in Sun Valley?

The resort introduced two new lifts at the Warm Springs base —Challenger, a high-speed 6-person lift with a midstation unload, and Flying Squirrel, a 4-person lift. These additions make accessing the mountain faster and open up the newly extended Lower Flying Squirrel trail, connecting skiers to the Warm Springs and River Run areas. The Challenger lift's vertical rise, at 3,138 feet, is now one of the highest in North America, enhancing the resort's appeal for advanced skiers.

In July, the resort launched a Village Master Plan that outlines future improvements, including enhanced parking, expanded food and retail options, and updated guest facilities, all while preserving the village's historic charm.

This winter, Sun Valley will host a 2025 Audi FIS Ski World Cup event. The first-ever Stifel Sun Valley Finals will be held from March 22-27, 2025, bringing together the world's top alpine ski competitors to compete in Downhill, Super-G, Giant Slalom, and Slalom events. This event is supported by a dedicated volunteer base, and registration for both on-hill and off-hill volunteers is now open.
